ELIGIBILITY & COSTS INVOLVED

All children from birth to grade 6

- The service is FREE for children who hold or whose parents hold a valid pensioner concession or health care card
- Non-cardholders pay a fee of \$28.00 per child (maximum of \$112 per family) for a
 general course of care, which includes a check up and all general dental care
- Please note, there is no fee for emergency dental care

All children enrolled in Special or Special Development Schools

- The service is FREE for children who hold or whose parents hold a valid pensioner concession or health care card
- Non-cardholders pay a fee of \$28.00 per child (maximum of \$112 per family) for a general course of care, which includes a check up and all general dental care
- Please note, there is no fee for emergency dental care

TYPE OF DENTAL CARE OFFERED

- General dental care may include:
 - o Check ups and consultations
 - o Diagnostic services, including x-rays
 - o Fillinas
 - Non-complicated extractions (removal of teeth)
 - Root fillings (except those requiring specialist care)
 - o Scaling and cleaning of teeth
 - o Dental sealants to prevent decay
