ATTITUDES TO SCHOOL SURVEY

The students in Grades 4, 5 and 6 completed the Attitudes to School Survey online. Below you will find a sample of student statements and the corresponding results in percentages. I am sure you will agree that we have a wonderful group of students who really respect and care for each other. It certainly makes me proud to be part of such a remarkable community. Over the next couple of weeks we will be holding de brief sessions with the students to look at the data, discuss what is going well, what needs improving

and what strategies we can put in place to address these. This is a major factor of incorporating "student voice" into our students' education. In the table below you will find some results in relation to questions answered. I have selected some overall positive results (highlighted in green) as well as some areas for improvement (highlighted in orange).

Students at this school treat teachers with respect.	52 %

I can talk to my teacher if something is worrying me.	63 %
My parents believe that going to school is important.	93 %
I can recover in a short time when something bad happens to me.	76 %
I have friends at this school.	93 %
My teacher makes sure all students feel included.	94 %
At this school, I help decide things like class activities or rules.	61 %
It is okay to be different at this school.	91 %
All students are treated fairly at this school.	60 %
