We have had such a wonderful start to Term One!

We begin each year with a Start Up program. During our Start Up program the teachers establish routines and expectations with the students. Our Start Up Program sets students up for the year. The students and teachers refer back to the routines and expectations throughout the year.

Our Foundation students have only been at school for a couple of weeks and they've already settled in beautifully! They know the routines and always begin their day by getting their tools ready for Sounds Write.

The Years Three and Five students are preparing for NAPLAN. NAPLAN will be in March this year and students sit tests for Reading, Writing, Language Conventions and Numeracy. For our Year Three students, this is the first time they will be sitting a NAPLAN test, so our teachers are showing them what tests look like and how to work through the questions.

Our Year One students have been working on the English Online Interview with their classroom teacher. The EOI is compulsory for our Foundation and Year One students. Teachers have assessed students' knowledge on Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening and will use the data to inform their teaching.

In some super exciting news, we now have a new library! The students are looking forward to visiting the library weekly to read and borrow.

Finally, we held a Reading Workshop on Wednesday for new parents. We had a fantastic turnout and there were some great questions!

Welcome back everyone, we have had a wonderful start to the year. The children have returned refreshed and ready to embrace lots of fantastic learning.

In 2022, the Victorian Department of Education updated its framework to hold wellbeing at its core, alongside learning. It now recognises that, as well as teaching knowledge and academic skills, it is the core business of schools to work with families in supporting and teaching students' resilience, wellbeing and positive social attitudes.



Wellbeing means developing the capabilities necessary to connect with others, respond positively to challenges and opportunities, and to feel successful. These capabilities are addressed officially within the curriculum, but also unofficially through various programs and day-to-day interactions.


The Personal and Social curriculum involves students learning to recognise and regulate emotions, develop empathy for others and understand relationships, establish and build a framework for positive relationships, work effectively in teams and develop leadership skills, and handle challenging situations constructively.

Here at school, it is not just in the classroom that these capabilities are learnt and practised, it is also in Specialist classes, in the yard at recess and lunch, and during the many wonderful and important additional activities such as incursions, excursions and special events.

To reinforce the relationship between wellbeing and learning, teachers and children have been working hard to better understand how we learn best. This can be the behaviours we show or the tools and resources we have in our classroom and school. We have been learning the purpose of daily schedules and routines, anchor charts and displays, as well as the many ways we move around and behave to show our school values.

A fantastic representation of this learning was shared by a 5/6 student and will be displayed on our Wellbeing Wall.

We look forward to another fantastic year exploring lots of new thinking and learning, in all things academic AND wellbeing.
